	The Title should be concise and not more than 21 words.  The Second page should contain the Manuscript Abstract of not more than 250 words; It should identify the contribution to existing knowledge
	The body of the Manuscript should have sub-division such as the problem, methodology, results, discussion and conclusion.
	Capitalize each word of the subheads only.
	The content of each sub-division should tally with the sub-title respectively.
	Use Times New Roman font, size 12 pt throughout.
	Non-English words should be italicised.
	Quotations of more than 40 words should be indented and single spaced.
	Arabic numerals below ten should be in words and higher numbers in figures.
	Authors should refer to current APA manuals for proper guidance.
